

Carl Sandburg Elementary Supply List 2008-2009

Kindergarten

Please do not label any of these materials as all the students will be sharing the supplies (except carpet square):

- 1 backpack (no wheels)
- 1 quality pair of children's scissors.
- 4 boxes of skinny Crayola Crayons (basic colors) – 24 pack
- 3 packages of Crayola Classic washable markers (8 per pack).
- 2 packages of glue sticks – we go through MANY glue sticks in a year.
- 4 containers of Baby wipes – we use these for washing our hands and tables before eating lunch.
- 2 two-pocket folders with the pockets at the bottom-please label your child's name on the upper right hand corner of the folder.
- 1 box of quart and 1 box of gallon size Zip-Loc bags.

All Day Kindergarten only

- 1 new carpet square (approximate size of 27"x16"). **Please honor this size request. Having rest mats all the same size helps for easy stacking in a small storage area.** The carpet square will be used at rest time and will only be used by your child. Please label this item with their name-

First Grade

Personal Items (Please label)

- 1 pair of pointed scissors (Fiskars are best)
- 1 package of washable markers (any brand)
- 1 large box of crayons (24 or so, in any brand)
- Plastic 8x5 Spacemaker school box
- Backpack (no wheels)
- 1 folder with bottom pockets (any design)
- 1 package of 12 (or so) colored pencils (any brand)
- 1 set of watercolor paints- (any size, any brand).

**Students in Mrs. Fornia/Guest's and Mrs. Morissey/Subcleff's class will need 2 sets*

Community items (Please do not label)

- 2 erasers (white "magic rub" work best)
- 4 boxes of baby wipes
- 2 black Sharpie markers
- 8+ glue sticks
- 12 #2 sharpened pencils
- 1 4oz. bottle of white Elmer's glue
- 1 box of tissues
- 2 thin dry erase pens, black or blue (Expo works well)
- Class snacks (shelf stable items such as goldfish crackers, granola bars, raisins) ** Needed throughout the year*

Optional (yet helpful) items- no need to label these

- 1 box, gallon or quart size, Ziploc bags

- 1 bottle hand sanitizer
- Pencil-top erasers (any amount)
- Paper plates to be used as art palettes
- Colored Sharpie markers
- Lunch size brown paper bags
- Cotton balls

Second Grade

- 3 dozen No. 2 pencils (SHARPENED)
- Highlighter (no more than 3)
- 1 set of 12 crayola watercolors
- 1 dry erase marker (blue or black only)
- 2 black Sharpie pen (one fine tip and one ultra fine tip)
- 1 box of markers (no more than 12)
- 1 box of baby wipes
- 1 package pencil top erasers/1-2 large pink erasers
- 1 small hand held pencil sharpener (with lid)
- Post-it notes (3X3, yellow or pale colors only)
- 2 boxes of Ziploc bags (sandwich and gallon size)
- 1 package of 5-7 oz. paper cups
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer

Labeled

- 1 pair of scissors
- Pencil box for desk (**about 8x4 /No other sizes, or pencil pouches please**)
- 4 folders (with pockets on bottom) –1 red, 1 yellow, 1 green, & 1 blue
- 1 folder (design of your choice)
- 2 **wide-ruled** spiral notebooks
- 1 box of crayons (only 24)
- 6 large glue sticks or 10+ small glue sticks- **the more the better**
- 1 box of colored pencils (pack of 12-24)
- 1 bottle Elmer's white glue

Please send all supplies in a large zip lock bag with your student's name on it. Only the supplies marked "labeled" need a name on the individual item.

Third Grade

- 3 ring notebook (metal rings are sturdier-1 ½" or 2")
- pencil box for desk (approx. 8" x 5")
- No. 2 pencils (sharpened)
- correcting pencils/pen
- Scissors (labeled)
- ruler (inch and centimeter)
- pink pearl eraser
- wide rule notebook paper
- crayons no larger than 24 in a box
- calculator
- 1- Spiral theme books-70 page count
- one fine point black felt tip pen (e.g. Sharpie)
- glue sticks or Elmer's Glue
- one or two highlighters (yellow, pink, green preferred)
- one box of Baby Wipes
- small hand held pencil sharpener (optional)
- composition-wide rules notebook
- 1-2 pocket folders with bottom pockets

Fourth Grade

Labeled with name

- 1 Sturdy backpack
- 1 3-Ring binder 1-1/2" (without zipper closer)
- 1 3-Hole Pencil Pouch
- 3 folders with paper fasteners (one is for music)
- 3 Composition Books (100 sheets) wide ruled
- 1 Set of colored Markers (No more than 15 markers or Scented Markers)
- 1 Set of Colored Pencils or Color Crayons (24 max.)
- 1 Standard sized plastic Pencil Box

- 1 Pink Pearl Eraser

- 1 Pencil Sharpener (one that catches the shavings)

- 24 #2 Pencils
- 1 Package of Binder Paper (200 count – College Ruled)
- 2 Large Glue Sticks
- 2 Packages of Post-It Notes (2-7/8 X 2-7/8 size)
- 1 Box of Kleenex

4th Grade Music:

- 1 Folder with 3 brads for music or small 3-ring notebook
- 1 pencil

Fifth Grade

- **3 ring binder** (2 inch rings) No zipper binders or trapper keepers.
- **Notebook dividers** (at least eight)
- **College ruled**-200 loose sheets-(only bring 50 sheets to school)
- **Graph paper** (with three holes to fit in binder) 20-50 sheets
- **5 Composition notebooks** – with lined paper composition books are (8 x 10)
- **Ruler** (standard & metric in one) with 3 holes, hard plastic or wood, (no folding or flimsy rulers)
- **4x6 cards pack of 100**-(may be left at home until needed)
- * **8 ballpoint pens** -2 black, 2 blue, 4 red, (only bring 1 black, 1 blue and 2 red to school)
- * **5-8 pencils** (#2) or mechanical pencils with lead and extra erasers (only bring 2 to school)
- * **Pencil sharpener** One that catches the shavings
- * **Highlighters**-2 (leave one at home)
- * **Colored pencil set** (High quality set-12 or more)
- * **Large eraser**
- * **Scissors** (must fit in pencil box)
- * **2 glue sticks**, (leave one at home)
- * **Calculator**-essential for math and science
- * **Protractor** (Compass optional-not used this year)
- * **Sticky notes** 3 x 3 and 1 x 2 ½
- * **2-Sharpies**, one ultra thin and one fatter.
- * **3-white board markers**
- **1- USB flash drive**
- 3-5 glue sticks & 1 bottle of white glue

Items with an *asterisk be brought to school in a **small plastic pencil box**.

Sixth Grade

- 2 Standard 3 ring binders: one- 1½ to 2" ring size for general use, and one- ½ to 1" ring size for science
- 10 Subject dividers for notebook
- 3 spiral notebooks, each 8½ x 11", single subject
- 3 ring plastic or canvas pencil pouch (no pencil boxes)
- Notebook paper, wide-lined, 3 holes-punched, white (Enough to last the year. Keep supply at home)
- 1 ream of copy paper
- Fine-line colored markers – Pentel or colored Sharpies
- 12" ruler, metric and standard (3-hole to fit in binder)
- 3 Red ballpoint pens
- Pencils #2 (Enough to last the year. Store extras at home)
- Large eraser (White art eraser is preferred)
- Colored pencil set
- Scissors, good quality
- White glue or glue stick
- Calculator
- Compass
- Protractor
- 1 standard box of tissue (soft on nose)
- Cleaning wipes for tables
- **1- USB flash drive**
